Media Release for Free and Reduced-Price Meals Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)—Year 2 and Successive Years

YORKTOWN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT has announced that it will continue its policy to operate the Community Eligibility Program (CEP) under the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program for the 2017-2018 school year. Schools qualifying to operate CEP serve breakfast and lunch to all children at no charge and eliminate the collection of meal applications for free, reduced-price, and paid student meals. This new approach reduces burdens for both families and school administrators and helps ensure that students receive nutritious meals.

For School Year **2017-2018**, EVERY YISD campus (Yorktown Elementary School, Yorktown Junior High School, and Yorktown High School) is qualified to serve breakfast and lunch to **all children at no charge**

NOTE: No application is required; however, Yorktown ISD is required to collect and report the socio-economic status of each student to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) for purposes of the annual state accountability ratings and for federal funding. Therefore, we appreciate your completion and return of the Socioeconomic Information Form. Your form information is not submitted to TEA.
